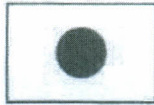

Sir/Madam,

On behalf of the Director-General I am pleased to inform you that, within the framework of the Japanese Funds-in-Trust for the Capacity-Building of Human Resources, the Government of Japan has generously offered to finance 10 research fellowships, responding to its commitment to impact on capacity-building. As you know, fellowships are an important tool in ensuring capacity-building in Member States and Associate Members concerned.

The UNESCO/Japan Young Researchers' Fellowship Programme focuses on post-graduate research activities in the following four areas:

1. environment, with particular emphasis on disaster risk reduction (DRR);
2. intercultural dialogue;
3. information and communication technologies; and
4. peaceful conflict resolution.

Aware of your Government's interest in the empowerment of your young researchers, I should be grateful if you would transmit this announcement to the interested governmental and non-governmental bodies, universities, institutes of higher education and scientific research institutes. All nominations should be submitted through your National Commission.

The target group, eligibility criteria, conditions and procedures for application, as well as the terms of the research fellowships, are set out in Annex I to this letter. To enable the Selection Committee to make the best possible choice, I should be grateful if you would arrange for your country's candidates - a maximum of two - to complete in the fullest possible detail the application form enclosed herewith as Annex II, and attach thereto the required forms. All applications should be received at UNESCO (Participation Programme and Fellowships Section) by midnight on **29 November 2019** at the latest. An advance copy may be sent by e-mail to s.bantchev@unesco.org and l.zas-friz@unesco.org.

The Programme functions according to the rules of open competition. As the number of research fellowships put at the disposal of UNESCO under this Programme is limited, only candidates with the necessary qualifications, who demonstrate outstanding intellectual qualities, imagination and personal commitment, will have a chance of being selected.

I am confident that this jointly-sponsored UNESCO/Japan Young Researchers' Fellowship Programme will serve to strengthen UNESCO's efforts to enhance the capacities of young researchers in areas crucial to global development.
